The following assessments were administered to assess Reading and Writing:

- **Fountas and Pinnell** to determine reading level A to Z.
- **Writing Baseline**

The following assessments were administered to assess understanding of Mathematical Concepts:

- **Go Math Baseline**
(Grades K to 5)
- **Schoolnet Baseline**
(Grades 3 to 8)

The following assessments were administered to determine the English proficiency of our students learning English as a second language:

- **ELL Baseline** (Reading, Writing, Listening and Speaking)
